Charleston County Mosquito Information

- 1. The mosquito is a known nuisance. However, some mosquitoes can also transmit diseases such as heartworm, Eastern Equine Encephalitis and the West Nile Virus.
- 2. Mosquitoes must have water to breed. Mosquito species that originate from water-holding containers do not travel far. If you have areas around your yard holding water, you may be breeding mosquitoes.
- 3. You can help reduce mosquitoes by eliminating unnecessary containers and other standing water around your home. Any Charleston County resident who is troubled by mosquitoes may contact the **Charleston County Mosquito Control Division by calling (843) 202-7880**. An inspector will respond to your request and seek out the cause of the problem.
